NEW RESOLUTION

The bathroom offers a fresh and modern look to a shady country retreat

This bathroom, located in a cool and sheltered country retreat, was the house's original, built some 25 years ago. Although spacious, it was dilapidated, out of date and dark – being on the south side of the dwelling. The general layout of the house also made access to the area awkward.

So the owners called on the professional design team at Bubbles Bathrooms to transform the space into a luxurious modern retreat. Doors were moved and a separate powder room created as part of the whole layout resolution.

"The main design anchor was to install a large new window, which allowed an uninterrupted view of the lush rural setting, more ambient light and fresh air, and a marvellous sense of space," says the designer from Bubbles Bathrooms. "There was no question that the soaker bath would then be located beneath this window."

It's easy to picture yourself settling in for a deep soak after a busy week. The views offered by the window serve to create

a relaxing and welcoming atmosphere in the space.

The owners wanted a separate shower installed, along with a generous vanity unit that is well illuminated and of high quality. The look was to be fresh and modern, but not in stark contrast to the rest of the house.

This important design requirement was achieved by the incorporation of high-quality modern fixtures and fittings against a muted colour palette. The darkened vanity, fittings, wall shower niche and shower in frameless glass all add details that make the bathroom restrained yet interesting.
