A modern, Asian-style kitchen was created with the use of a dark-toned wood grain for the cabinets and drawers, and a natural glass splashback behind the cooktop and around the shelf on the island bench. A new dishwasher and rangehood were integrated into the design. Double overhead cabinets were installed to provide maximum storage. Recessed cabinet lighting and extra ceiling downlights help create a bright and uplifting finish.

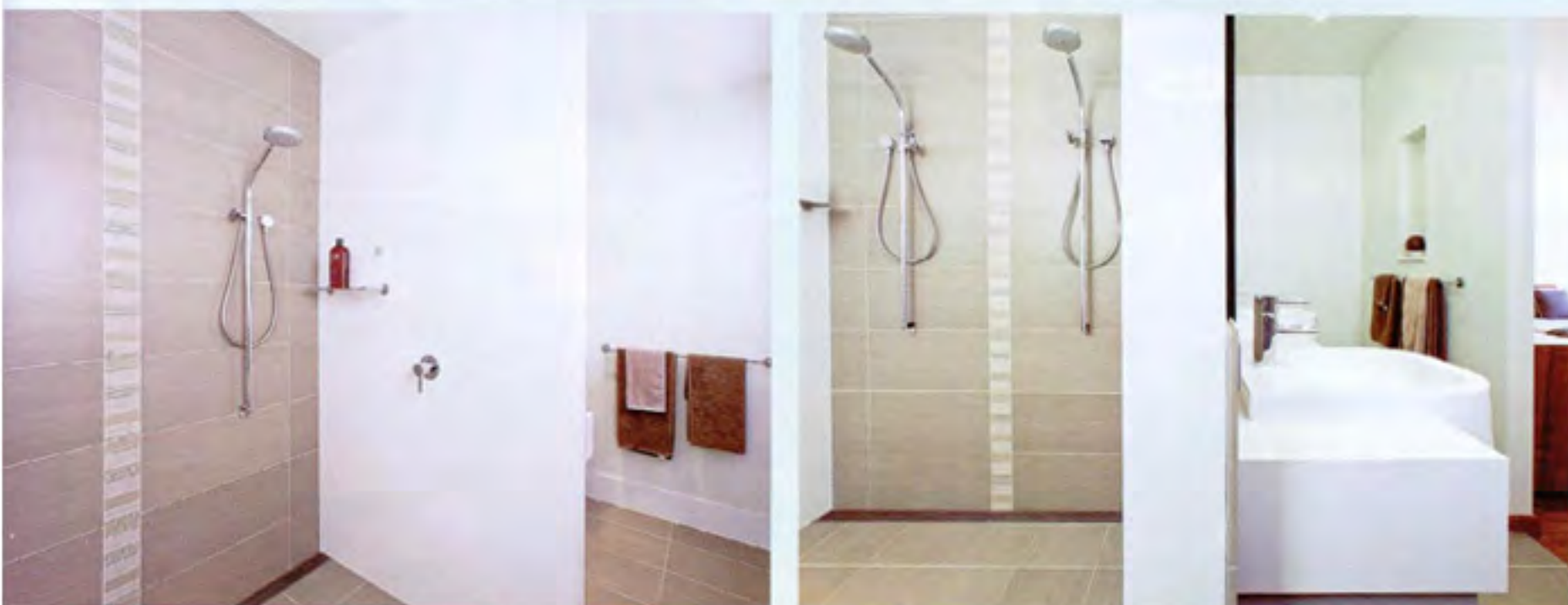

The aim was to create a cleaner look and smarter design to this ensuite that opens up to the main bedroom. It initially contained a spa that wasn't being used, so this was moved to another bathroom, freeing up space for a walk-in shower to the left and toilet and storage cupboard to the right. The walk-in shower sits behind the walled vanity unit. A glass brick window was changed to translucent glass. A double basin with cabinets runs across the doorway and a huge mirror sits above the vanity area. Feature tiles of a similar colour scheme to the bedroom help create a link between rooms and a more visually appealing finish.
